## Where:

- The McIntosh Centre at Shepparton Showgrounds

## Who:

- All 16-18yr olds plus the people that they live with
- Teachers and all school support staff

## What:

- Vaccine brand will be offered inline with the Victorian guidelines, generally Pfizer for those aged 16-59 and AstraZeneca for those aged 60 and over
- Second doses will be booked with a view them not impacting upon exam time
