Dear families,

We would like to share some information about our transition activities that will support our students as they progress into their new year level but also as they transition to our new campus.

Our School Leadership and Wellbeing team have designed a transition program that will familiarize them with their new school facilities, help them to begin forming relationships with their key supports next year, and will establish our expectations for the beginning of 2022.



Unfortunately due to the impacts of COVID and delays to completion to the site, we will not be able to take students through the new site before the end of the year. As a result, we will be providing some transition opportunities in the last week of the school holidays and at the beginning of Term 1 - you will find more information below.

### **Orientation Afternoons**

All students within Years 7 to 9 will have an orientation afternoon, where they will spend the afternoon with their 2022 Home Group Teacher and 2022 House Leader at their <u>current</u> campus. They will participate in fun and engaging activities with their Home Group and House classmates and key staff, and becoming familiar with the new facilities, routines and expectations.

Both their Home Group teacher and House Leader will be key supports for our students in 2022 and we wanted to prioritise them having time together this year. In 2022, we will be returning to a morning Home Group program and our students will also have regular sessions with their House Leader.
