NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) 2022 tests will be undertaken by all Australian Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 students from 10th to 20th May 2022. Students will be tested in Writing, Language Conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation), Reading and Numeracy. The NAPLAN tests are implemented by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) on behalf of the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA).

The results of the tests provide information for students, parents, teachers and principals which can be used to improve student achievement.

Students with significant intellectual disabilities can be exempted from one or all of the NAPLAN 2022 tests. In certain circumstances, adjustments are available for students to enable them to participate in the tests. In addition, whilst NAPLAN tests are a routine part of the school calendar, students may be withdrawn from the testing program by their parent/guardian for reasons such as religious beliefs or philosophical objections to testing.
