
MAKE THE RIGHT CHOICE

Either don't bring your devices to school or secure it in your locker at first bell. It must remain there until the final school bell.




REFUSAL TO COMPLY

If a student is seen with device in class or yard they will be required to hand over the device to the staff member.

The device will be secured in the main office until the end of the day when the student can collect it.

Note that after the first offence, parent/carers warned that devices will be retained by school for any further infraction and the device can only be collected by a parent/carer.
