BAR Reports

Behaviour and Attitude Reports, or BAR Rubrics assess a students' progress in a range of areas related to their personal growth and attitudes to learning. This includes attendance and effort and behaviour in all core and elective subjects, as well as Home Group, Connect and Pathways and Mentoring (PAM).

END OF EACH SEMESTER

Academic Reports

These are referred to as Semester Reports and are provided at the end of Term 2 (Semester 1) and Term 4 (Semester 2), with the exception of Year 12 students who do not receive a Semester 2 Report.

Semester Reports are your traditional academic reports, which include comments from your student's teachers in each subject

TWICE PER YEAR

Student Engagement Conferences

These are what you may know as Parent / Student / Teacher interviews. Conferences are held twice a year and can be booked online or in person.

These provide a great way for students and families to connect with teachers one-on-one, to discuss your progress, goals and seek any feedback to assist you with your learning.

THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

CAT & SAC feedback

Students in Years 7 to 10 regularly undertake Common Assessment Tasks (CATs) while senior students in Years 11-12 complete School-Assessed Coursework (SACs) or School-Assessed Tasks (SATs). These all assess student's understanding and knowledge of the coursework undertaken in class across their various subjects.
